Additional conference offerings include: webinars covering many aspects of and updates to LEED products; a case study review and a tour of our venue, the first LEED Platinum building in the City of Phoenix; as well as the Audubon Society’s Bird Walks and Field Exploration with Naturalist Packs. The Annual Membership Meeting rounds out the day with the annual State of the Chapter, USGBC Arizona 2012 leadership introductions, chapter volunteer and partner recognitions along the dedication of the new ASU Excellence in Sustainability Scholarship established by USGBC Arizona in honor of the victims and survivors of the Tucson shooting. Showcasing LEED-certified projects within Arizona, the evening will close with a special guest speaker and cocktail reception.

In our first year, we are anticipating 100-150 attendees from across Arizona. These attendees include USGBC Arizona members along with professionals in the architecture & engineering, construction, building managers, institutional and private developers, government and institutional officials, facility and building operation managers, and related community interested in “green” planning, construction and building operations and maintenance with a focus on LEED® projects.
